Roachester-Cozaddale Road to Close for 12 Weeks for Bridge Rehabilitation

Lebanon, Ohio – Harlan Township, Warren County, Ohio – Roachester-Cozaddale Road Bridge #52-4.02, over First Creek, between Morrow-Rossburg Road and Achterman Road, will be closed for rehabilitation beginning Monday, May 6, 2024, for twelve (12) weeks, weather permitting.

The bridge rehabilitation will be constructed by Ford Development Corp. and the project is funded by the County Engineer's Association of Ohio and the Warren County Engineer's Office.

The detour for the closure will utilize Morrow-Rossburg Road, SR132, and Morrow-Woodville Road.

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About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
