Ross Leever Road Daytime Closures for 5 Days

Lebanon, Ohio – Harlan Township, Warren County, Ohio – Ross Leever Road, just north of the intersection of Ross Leever Road and Vandervoort Road, shall be closed during the daytime hours of 8:00am to 3:00pm beginning Monday, June 17th, 2024 for five (5) days, weather permitting. The closure is for utility pole/utility line work and will be completed by a contractor for Duke Energy.

The detour for the closures will utilize SR28, Morrow-Woodville Road, and Vandervoort Road.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
