McClure Road to Close for 12 Weeks for Bridge Rehabilitation

Lebanon, Ohio – City of Lebanon, Warren County, Ohio – McClure Road Bridge #71-0.39, over Turtle Creek, between Hamilton Road and US 42, will be closed for rehabilitation beginning Monday, July 8, 2024, for twelve (12) weeks, weather permitting. The closure location on McClure Road is between addresses 650 and 900.

The bridge rehabilitation will be constructed by DDK Construction and the project is funded by the County Engineer's Association of Ohio and the Warren County Engineer's Office.

The detour for the closure will utilize Hamilton Road, SR 63, Glosser-Richardson Road, and US 42.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
