Fosters-Maineville Road and Sibcy Road to Close.

Maineville, Ohio – Hamilton Township, Warren County, Ohio – Fosters-Maineville Road and Sibcy Road will be closed at the intersection of Fosters-Maineville Road and Sibcy Road, beginning Wednesday, September 4th, 2024, for three (3) days, weather permitting. Fosters-Maineville Road will be closed between the addresses of 668 Fosters-Maineville Road and 637 Fosters-Maineville Road. Sibcy Road will be closed north of address 8108 Sibcy Road. The closure is for an underground utility construction, which will be completed by a contractor for the Warren County Water and Sewer Department.

The detour for the closure of Fosters-Maineville Road will utilize Old 3'C Highway, US22/SR3 and SR48.

The detour for the closure of Sibcy Road will utilize Butterworth Road, Fosters-Maineville Road, Old 3'C Highway, US22/SR3 and SR48.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
