**RE: Columbia Road and Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road Expect Long Delays**

Lebanon, Ohio – Union Township, Warren County, Ohio – Columbia Road and Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road will experience long delays during the construction of a compact roundabout beginning Monday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024 for four (4) weeks, weather permitting. The compact roundabout will be constructed of recycled materials that are secured to the pavement.

The roundabout will be constructed by Barrett Paving Materials and the project is funded by the Warren County Board of County Commissioners and the Warren County Engineer's Office through the Warren County Transportation Improvement District.

No detour will be posted and we recommend to avoid this intersection during construction.

**About the Warren County Engineer**

*County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.*
