RE: Columbia Road and Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road Intersection Closure

Lebanon, Ohio – Union Township, Warren County, Ohio – Columbia Road and Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road eastern intersection will be closed from Friday, October 18th, 2024, at 8:00pm until Monday, October 21st, 2024, at 6:00am, weather permitting. The closure is for the installation of the compact roundabout. The compact roundabout will be constructed of recycled materials that will be secured to the pavement.

The roundabout will be constructed by Barrett Paving Materials and the project is funded by the Warren County Board of County Commissioners and the Warren County Engineer's Office through the Warren County Transportation Improvement District.

The detour for Columbia Road North will utilize SR48, I-71, SR741 and US42.

The detour for Columbia Road South will utilize SR48, I-71, SR741 and US42.

The detour for Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road West will utilize SR48, I-71, SR741 and US42.

The detour for Mason-Morrow-Millgrove Road East will utilize US42, SR741, I-71 and SR48.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
