Wilkins Blvd. and Bardes Road Intersection Closure

Lebanon, Ohio – Deerfield Township, Warren County, Ohio – Wilkins Blvd. and Bardes Road intersection will be closed for the construction of a roundabout beginning on Wednesday, April 16th, 2025, for sixteen (16) weeks, weather permitting. The closure is for the construction of a modern roundabout and associated roadway items. Access to 9805 Wilkins Blvd (iStorage) will be maintained but only from the north.

The detour for this closure will utilize Merten Drive, Mason-Montgomery Road, Escort Drive and Fields-Ertel Road.

This project will be constructed by the John R. Jurgensen Company for a bid amount of \$2,462,777.24. This project is funded by the Warren County Commissioners and Warren County Engineer's Office through the Warren County Transportation Improvement District.

About the Warren County Engineer

County Engineers in Ohio are required by law to be registered as both Professional Engineers (P.E.) and Professional Surveyors (P.S.) They are responsible for the maintenance and construction of county roads and maintenance and construction of bridges on county roads, township roads, and certain streets within municipalities. They are also responsible for maintaining land surveying records, checking the accuracy and adequacy of recorded land transfer documents, and establishing or re-establishing certain land survey monuments.
