

SR 48 BRIDGE MAINTENANCE PROJECT



PROJECT SCOPE: The two-lane bridge that carries traffic over the Little Miami River on State Route (SR) 48 is undergoing routine maintenance work. Crews are replacing the concrete surface on the bridge, constructing new walls, painting bridge deck beams, and completing other general maintenance tasks.

PROJECT BENEFITS:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is responsible for maintaining thousands of bridges throughout the state, which includes the routine inspection and upkeep of these structures. The work on the SR 48 bridge is part of a routine program to ensure safety and the ongoing use of the bridge. New lanes will not be added as part of the current project.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

MONDAY, JUNE 1 – FRIDAY, AUG. 14, WEATHER PERMITTING:

Maintenance work will require a full closure of the bridge beginning Monday, June 1, for approximately 75 days, weather permitting.



KING AVE. BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT



PROJECT SCOPE: The King Ave. Bridge carries two lanes of traffic across the Little Miami River in Warren County. The bridge will remain in its current two-lane configuration, but the lanes will be widened, and safety shoulders will be added in both directions. The new structure will be built upstream of the existing bridge crossing.

In addition, a new 10-foot multi-use path will be built on the new bridge that will separate pedestrians from traffic, and a tunnel will be built for a portion of the Little Miami Scenic Bike Trail, which will separate the trail from Grandin Rd.

A new parking lot for Little Miami Scenic Bike Trail users will be built and the project also will include a new roundabout at the intersection of the Peters Cartridge Factory development and parking lot access for the trail.

PROJECT BENEFITS:

The Warren County Engineers Office is responsible for maintaining nearly 400 bridges throughout the county, which includes the routine inspection and upkeep of these structures. The work on the King Ave. Bridge is part of a regular program to ensure safety and the ongoing use of the bridge.

New wider lanes and shoulders will improve safety for vehicles who use the bridge and separating the bike path from the roadway will significantly improve safety for users of the Little Miami Scenic Bike Trail.



TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

King Ave. and Grandin Rd. near the Little Miami River will be closed to traffic for approximately four months so that the new bridge structure can be connected to the existing roadway.

Access to the development at the Peters Cartridge Factory will be limited during different phases of construction.

A portion of the Little Miami Scenic Bike Trail will be closed during most of the construction.

US 22 BRIDGE MAINTENANCE PROJECT



PROJECT SCOPE: The bridge that carries US 22 traffic over the Little Miami River will undergo routine maintenance during the summer of 2021. Crews will replace the concrete surface on the bridge and complete other general maintenance tasks.



PROJECT BENEFITS:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is responsible for maintaining thousands of bridges throughout the state, which includes the routine inspection and upkeep of these structures. The work on the US 22 bridge is part of a routine program to ensure safety and the ongoing use of the bridge. New lanes will not be added as part of the current project.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

Maintenance work will require a full closure of the bridge for approximately 50 days, weather permitting. In addition, prior to the bridge closure, Foster-Maineville Rd. and a portion of the Little Miami Scenic Trail under the bridge is expected to be closed for approximately 14 days. Traffic across the bridge will be maintained during this 14-day period.
